A username and password will be sent by e-mail to the participants of the conference.



TRANSPORTATION

FLYING INTO BRATISLAVA VIA VIENNA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Vienna International Airport/Flughafen Schwechat is a popular choice when travelling to Bratislava due to its proximity (40 km) and excellent connections.

There is a direct bus connection from the airport to the centre of Bratislava. Buses leave the airport approx. every 30 minutes, the journey takes approx. one hour and the cost varies according to the time and provider, from €1 to €10. FLYING INTO BRATISLAVA

Bratislava Airport/Letisko Bratislava offers the largest number of international connections in Slovakia. Bratislava airport is connected to the centre of Bratislava by public transport or by taxis (Please see *Transport in the City* section).

ARRIVAL AT BRATISLAVA CENTRAL RAILWAY STATION

The Central Railway Station is situated 1 km north of the historical city centre Old Town. The station is well connected to the whole city by public transport.

Bratislava is also conveniently connected with many European cities via a network of bus lines. The buses arrive and depart from Mlynske Nivy Bus Station.

TRANSPORT IN THE CITY

a) Buses, trams and trolleybuses

The public transport network in Bratislava is dense. Although there is no subway in the city, there are buses, trams and trolleybuses. Night buses run every hour. Tickets are purchased from a ticket vending machine at bus stops or newsstands and are valid for a specific period of time. It is necessary to validate them in the vehicle. These through-tickets are valid for all types of public transport in the city. The shortest period tickets are valid for 15 minutes and cost 70 cents.

b) Taxi

Several taxi companies offer their services in the city. They are available 24 hours a day and are located outside the arrivals area at Bratislava airport, as well as in front of Central Railway Station and



Central Bus Station. A cheaper option is to book a taxi by phone or via a mobile app- the most widely used application is called Hopin *www.hopin.sk*. Taxis standing at taxi ranks are traditionally more expensive.

c) On foot

Due to the short distances, walking is often the most convenient option in much of the city centre. The Old Town is a single large pedestrian zone, so the majority of attractions in the city can be visited on foot.

Language: The official language spoken in Slovakia is Slovak.

Time in Slovakia: Central European Time (GMT+1)

International dial code for Slovakia: +421 Currency: The currency of Slovakia is Euro.

Credit cards: All major credit cards are generally accepted everywhere.

Smoking: All restaurants are fully or partially non-smoking. Some cafés and pubs still allow smoking, but cannot serve food due to the anti-smoking law requirements. Smoking is permitted in most open areas with some exceptions.

Shop opening hours: Most of the shops in the city of Bratislava close at 18:00, grocery shops and shops in the shopping malls close usually later, at 21.00.
